

# Things Good Readers Do

Preview	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Look at the cover and title.</li><li>• Look at some of the pictures and read some of the text.</li></ul>
Question	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ask who, what, when, where, why and how.</li><li>• Decide if what you've read makes sense.</li></ul>
Predict	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Wonder about what will happen next.</li><li>• Make guesses and read ahead to see if your predictions are correct.</li></ul>
Infer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Imagine the details.</li><li>• Use what to understand what the author means.</li></ul>
Connect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Relate what you've read to what you know, and to your thoughts and feelings.</li><li>• Compare what you've read to other texts and to the world around you.</li></ul>
Summarize	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Organize and connect the details.</li><li>• Draw your own conclusion.</li></ul>
Evaluate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Think about what you've read.</li><li>• What did you learn?</li><li>• Was it important to you? Why or why not?</li><li>• Did you like it? Why or why not?</li></ul>
